Sleek, multi-purpose transmitter with 4 built-in directional microphones



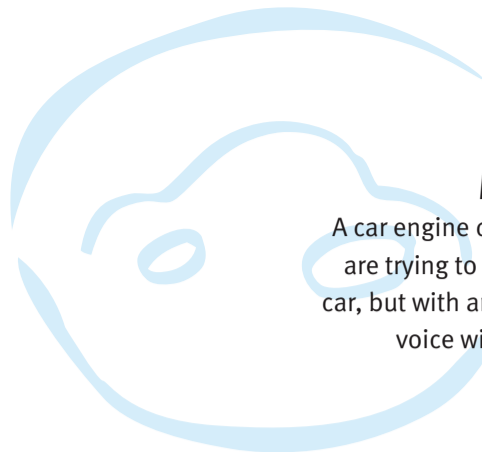
**Amigo T5**

A car engine can be a real obstacle when you are trying to understand conversation in the car, but with an Amigo transmitter the driver's voice will come through loud and clear.

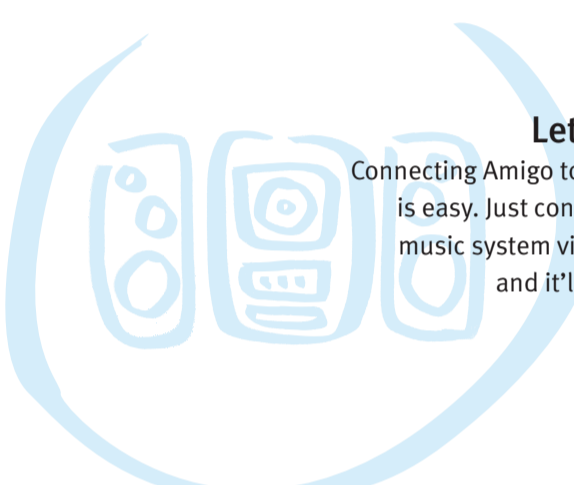
### Stay on track when on the move

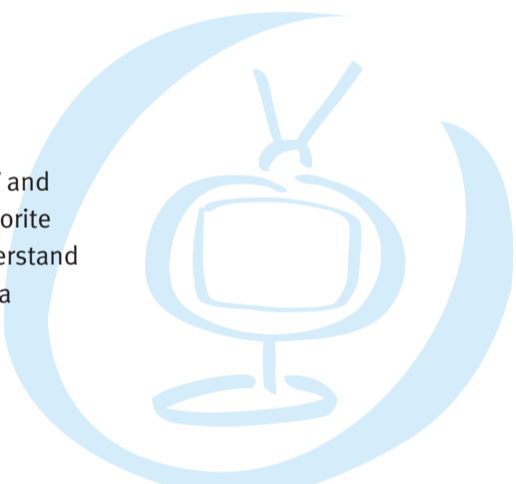
### Let the music get you

Portable music device	None	Connect the 3.5mm end of the DAI cord directly to the portable music device; and the other end to the DAI shoes on your hearing aids.	None
