

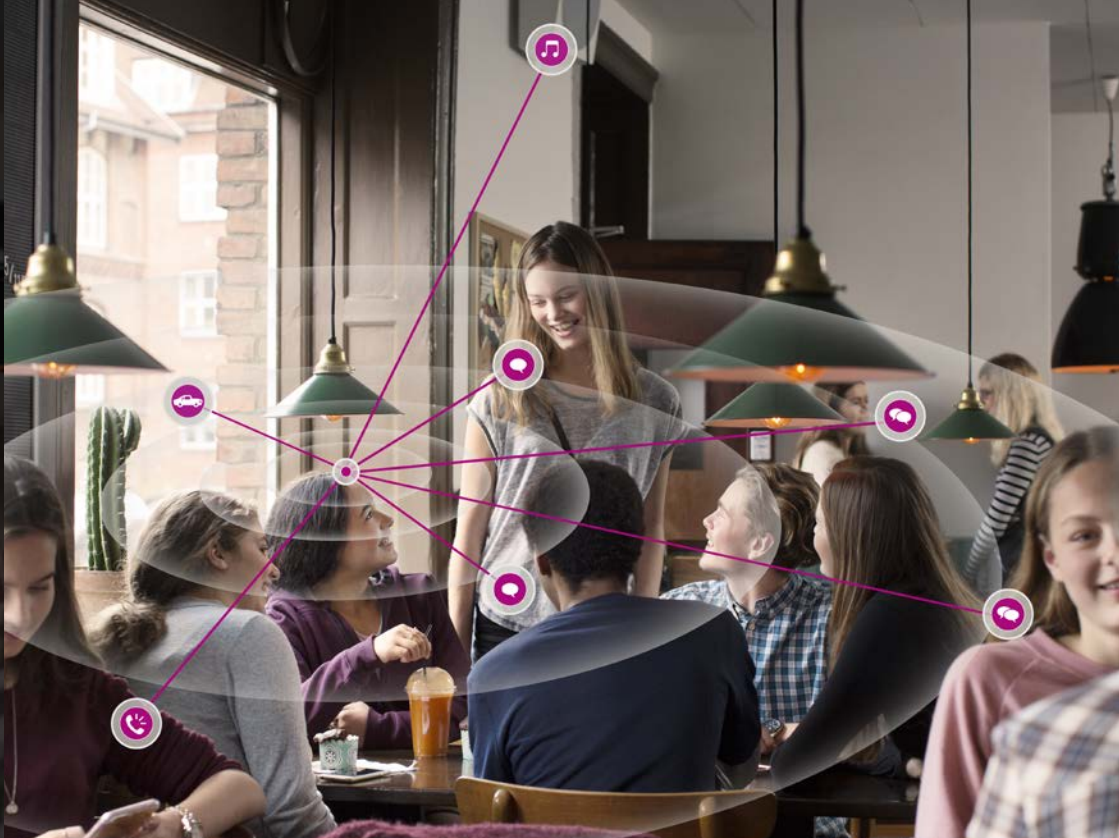

Traditional technology

Focuses on one speaker and suppresses all others

Before Oticon Opn™, the most effective way to get rid of noise only allowed you to focus on one sound source at a time, like one of your friends speaking in front of you, and would then block out all other sounds.

However, background sounds often include important speech details. When these are not passed on to your brain, you can get tired, and it becomes really difficult to keep up with your friends. By reducing sounds coming from around you – speech and noise alike – traditional hearing aids may give you an unnatural perception of your world.

Control at your fingers

The Oticon ON App is available for iPhone and Android™, letting you control your hearing aids by adjusting the volume and program with a tap of your finger. The app also has a “find my hearing aids” feature if you lose them.

Be part of the Internet of Things (IoT) and IFTTT

If This Then That (IFTTT.com) lets you program Oticon Opn in a variety of creative ways, from pinging your hearing aids when you get a text, when your battery is low, or when your friends ring the doorbell.

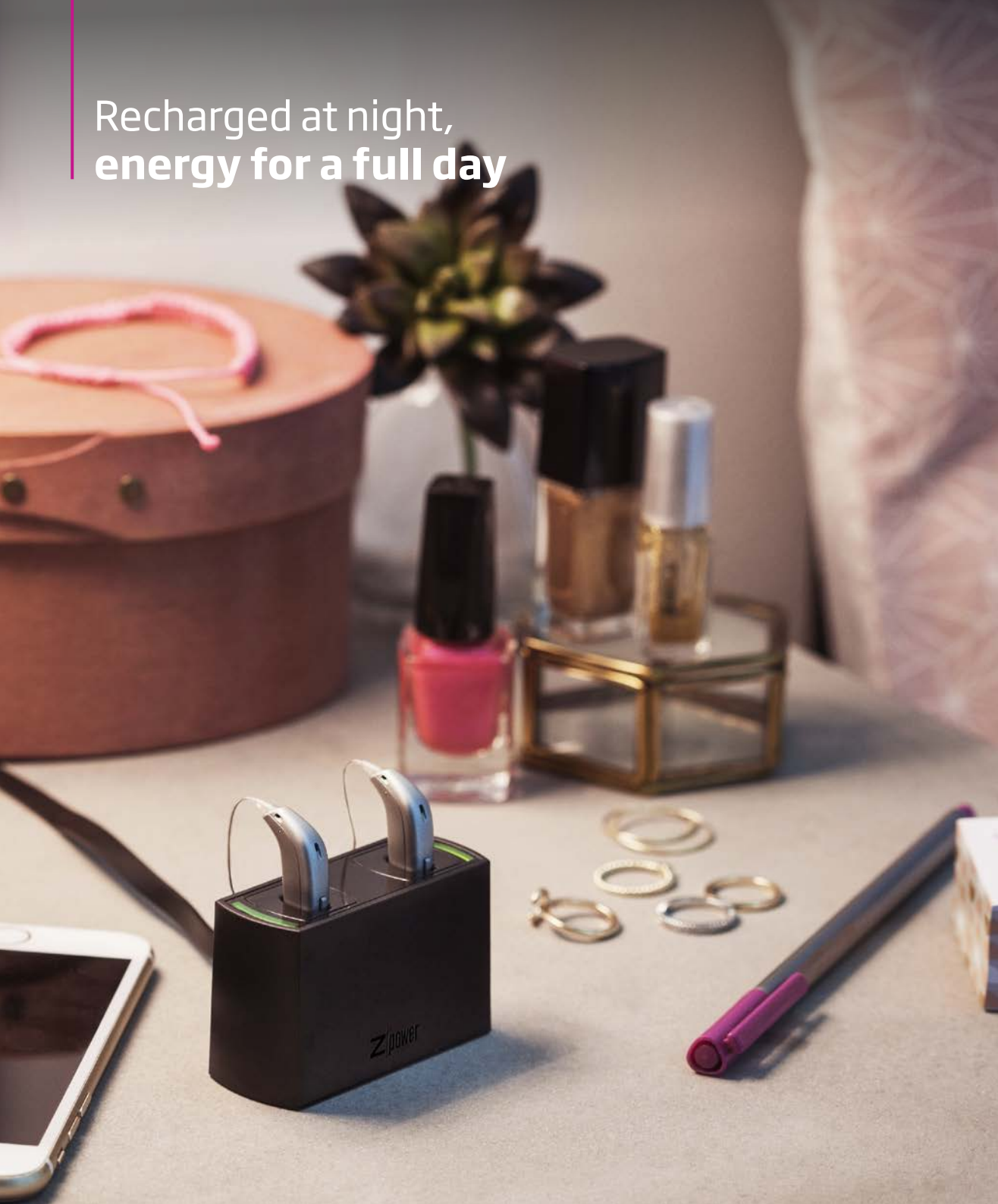

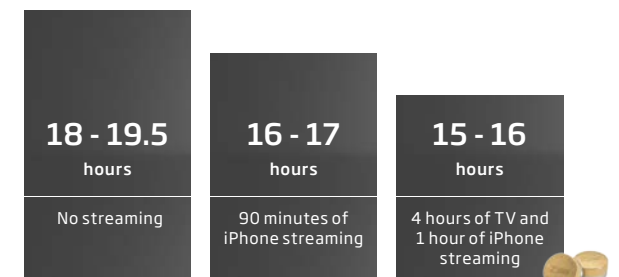

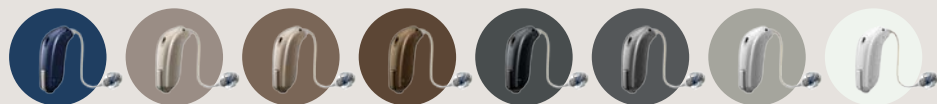
